As you will have heard by now, the Government has decided to impose level three restrictions on the whole country from midnight Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October. Unfortunately, there are a number of implications for ourselves in that development.

- 1. All Church services will cease at level three.
- 2. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend funeral services.
- 3. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend wedding services.
- 4. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to one's own county.
- 5. Baptisms will be postponed at level three as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

This development is most unfortunate but everyone's safety must come first and I look forward to seeing you share in the liturgies in our Church once restrictions are lifted.

The Parish Office will remain open from Tuesday - Friday 10am to 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch) and I will continue to say private Masses for any intentions that have already been booked.
