Today we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, that great number of our brothers and sisters who already give eternal praise to God.

FEAST OF ALL SOULS

Tomorrow is the Feast of All Souls. Belief in the resurrection of the dead is an essential part of our Christian faith. It implies a particular understanding of the inescapable mystery of death. Death is the end of our earthly life, but 'not of our existence' (St Ambrose) since the soul is immortal. The Church prays for the faithful departed asking for them eternal life, but not only for the disciples of Christ who have died in his peace, but for "all the dead whose faith is known to God alone". Therefore in our Catholic tradition we have the custom of praving for the faithful departed particularly during the month of November. During this time we are encouraged to visit our cemeteries and Churches and while their, be mindful of the dead and ask Gods mercy on them. This prayer is taken from the service for Christian burial.

Lord God,

Whose days are without end and whose mercies beyond counting,

Keep us mindful that life is short and the hour of our death unknown.

Let your Spirit guide our days on earth in the ways of holiness and justice,

That we may serve you in union with the whole Church, sure in faith, strong in hope, perfect in love.

And when our earthly journey is ended, lead us rejoicing into your kingdom, where you live for ever and ever. Amen.

The Irish Bishops have dedicated the Month of November to those who have died during the year, be it from COVID or other causes. The absence of the usual funeral rites and the loss of community support has impacted greatly on many. Bishop Tom Deenihan will be presiding at Evening Prayer in the Cathedral in Mullingar at 6pm on Sunday 1st November. The service will be broadcast on the Cathedral Webcam, www.mullingarparish.ie Level 5 restrictions will affect Church Services as detailed below:

- 1. Churches will remain open for private prayer.
- 2. Public Masses will cease.
- 3. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend funeral services.
- 4. A maximum of twenty-five people may attend wedding services.
- 5. Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to 5k from your home.
- 6. Baptisms will be postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

The Parish Office will remain open from Tuesday - Friday 10am to 5pm (closed 1-2pm for lunch) and private Masses will be offered for any intentions that have already been booked.
