GUIDELINES WHEN ATTENDING MASS

- People entering the Church at the side entrances will be directed to the top two sections of the Church, with no more than 50 people allowed in both sections.
- People entering the church at the main entrance will be directed to the bottom two sections of the Church, with no more than 50 people allowed in both sections.
- If no room is available in the main Church sections, you will be directed to the gallery.
- When the gallery has reached full capacity, no one further will be allowed to enter the Church.
- Please sit at either end of the Pews to ensure social distancing at all times.
- **DO NOT SIT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE** PEWS.
- There is strictly no movement of people between sections before, during or after the service.
- After Mass please exit the Church via the door you entered, ensuring social distancing
- Parishioners should not congregate outside, before or after any services.
- Please note to limit the number of people attending any given Mass we can only include 2 intentions per Mass.
