- Baptisms will be postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.

Planning permission has been granted for 18 one bedroom and 4 two bedroom houses. These will be used by elderly and people with limited mobility and will be a great addition to the village of Duleek.
