### THE CELEBRATION OF MASS

After the long periods of not being able to attend our churches for the celebration of Mass, we now savour the blessed privilege it is to gather again as faith communities around the sacred altars. The gift of modern means of communication assisted greatly in keeping us all connected to the celebration of Mass here in our parishes or via the RTE News Now channel, LMFM and lots of other providers nationally and internationally. Such weekly and indeed daily service was and continues to be greatly appreciated. We pray for the endeavours of all who work in the various means of communications, as they enable us when needed to participate in virtual communion for the celebration of Mass.

For all of us currently back again in church we pray that the spike in the delta variant of the coronavirus may subside quickly, so as the numbers permitted indoors for religious worship may soon be expanded. As we slowly get back to a semblance of normality, let us be conscious of the sacred worship we participate in.

- For the Opening Rites of the Mass we stand until the celebration of the Liturgy of the Word.
- For now, after the preparation of the gifts on the altar, the congregation stands for the entire Eucharistic Prayer, as we implore the Holy Spirit of God for the consecration of the Body & Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.
- We remain standing for the Saviour's Prayer and the Communion Rite.
- As usual the priests and the ministers of Holy Communion will distribute Holy Communion through the pews/seats.
- Please remain standing or gesture if you wish to receive.
- After the period of personal prayer and thanksgiving, the priest will invite all to stand for the Concluding Prayer and Blessing.

We express our thanks to the Sacristans, those who help with the sanitising, the Ministers of the Word & Holy Communion, those involved with music, the welcoming stewards and collectors, for their generous assistance at our celebrations of Mass at the weekend and during the week. It is hugely appreciated as we gather with respect and safely to worship God and celebrate the precious gift of Holy Mass.

#### MASS CARDS

As you know Mass Cards are readily available in our Parish Offices and in the sacristies. The regulated Catholic Church Mass stipend per Mass Card offering is  $\in 10$ . Every priest must ensure that the Mass intention for each Mass Card, signed in his name, is offered at a particular individual Mass. As a priest is only allowed to offer one Mass per day, unless for particular pastoral reasons as permitted by the Universal Catholic Church and the local Bishop, priests usually send on the requested Mass intentions to other priests to offer the specific Mass intention as soon as they can. Here in our parishes Fr. Mark will send on such Mass intentions to missionary priests abroad, as well as to Fr. Anthony, who will also ensure the particular Mass intentions entrusted to his care are offered.
