

Parish Income fell by 16% from 2019 to 2021, predominantly due to COVID-19. Although the impact of Covid-19 reduced income, the parish has continued to provide ongoing support to the faith community at a time when the need for such support was greater than ever. A practical review of the parish facilities, including buildings, has now been carried out. Such reviews are best practice and essential to ensure that the parish facilities are adequate to meet the needs of the faith community into the future. A number of essential projects have been identified and work is ongoing to estimate the potential costs of these projects. The sale of the site behind The Old Teachers Residence is at sale agreed stage. Some examples of the projects include, fencing and signage behind the parochial house yard due to anti-social behaviour, repair of gates and railings at Holy Cross cemetery which have also been painted, more work to be carried out on the pathways; upgrading of St. Cianán's Duleek including toilets etc; repair of the hall and upgrading of St. Therese's church facilities in Bellewstown. The basket Offertory Collection at Mass assists with the day to day parish expenditure. The weekly Parish Envelope Development Fund is an essential source to carry out the necessary work to maintain the parish facilities to the standard required to meet the needs of our faith community. There is also the Charitable Donations scheme via the Revenue which parishioners can avail of for yearly donations of €250 and above. Details regarding this scheme can be obtained from the Parish Office along with the weekly Parish Envelopes and Direct Debit details. We express our gratitude for all that has been given and for your continued support.
