THE EASTER VIGIL These weeks of the Lenten journey leads us to the great commemoration of the Life, Death and Resurrection of our Saviour Jesus Christ. We enter into Holy Week as if we were there, when Jesus endured the adulation of the crowd as he entered Jerusalem, and there mocking him as he suffered and died on Calvary. We celebrate our baptismal identity and recall how we have all been baptised into his death and resurrection. This Easter Vigil Ian Heaton, after his journey of RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will be baptised, confirmed and will receive Holy Communion as we welcome him into the Faith Community. Pray for him and other adults in our diocese and around the world being received into the Church this Easter.
