The General Secretariat of the Synod of Bishops has published the working document, known as the *Instrumentum Laboris*, for the second session of the Universal Synod that will be held in Rome in October. This document is the fruit of consultation and discernment that took place across the world earlier this year. The consultation that took place in the Diocese of Meath formed part of the submission of the Irish Episcopal Conference. questions that the *Instrumentum Laboris* asks are: how to be a synodal Church in mission; how to engage in deep listening and dialogue; how to be co-responsible in the light of the dynamism of our personal and communal baptismal vocation; how to transform structures and processes so that all may participate and share the charisms that the Spirit pours out on each for the common good; how to exercise power and authority as service. Each of these questions is a service to the Church and, through its action, to the possibility of healing the deepest wounds of our time." (**How to be a missionary synodal Church**, p.48)

SEEKING A BLESSING It is custom to have a new house or car blessed; perhaps even the farm too or the office or work place for God's protection etc. Please don't hesitate to request such a blessing from Fr. Mark or Fr. Declan. Always feel free to phone or email the Parish Office to make arrangements. Also if permitted by the hospital or nursing residence Fr. Mark and Fr. Declan would gladly visit any parishioner if they or their family so desired. Be assured too that most hospitals and nursing care facilities usually have pastoral care procedures provided for Anointing the sick and bringing Holy Communion, just ask and they will make arrangements for you and your loved ones.



THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Did you know that the Sacrament of Marriage can be celebrated simply with the Liturgy of the Word or also with the Liturgy of the Eucharist. For a valid celebration the couple need only the priest and two witness! So no need for a big crowd or to be worried about costs! There are many options for couples to think about when planning their wedding! To make arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage please contact the Parish Office. The completed Sacrament of Marriage Booking Form is then returned at the weekend Mass, after which the priest will bless the couple as they begin the spiritual journey to their wedding day. Please keep all engaged couples in prayer as they prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage and living it 'for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and health, all the days of their lives'.
