For a valid celebration the couple need only the priest and two witness! So no need for a big crowd or to be worried about costs! There are many options for couples to think about when planning their wedding! To make arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage please contact the Parish Office. The completed Sacrament of Marriage Booking Form is then returned at the weekend Mass, after which the priest will bless the couple as they begin the spiritual journey to their wedding day. Please keep all engaged couples in prayer as they prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage and living it 'for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and health, all the days of their lives'.*
